The video recording of the Housing Diversity Study Committee meeting on Monday, August 28, 2023 was edited to remove two minutes of disruptive audio at approximately six minutes from the start. Public comments from Cynthia Dill were being given at that point. Below is a transcription of what was said immediately before (a.) the edit and immediately after(b.):

- (a.) On Drown Road in Cumberland, "You will see a school which is adjacent to a capped landfill that has a solar array on it, and so it does happen and it has worked so well that the Town of Cumberland is actually citing another project of low-income housing right next door. So, as close to the landfill as it could possibly be, it works for Cumberland."
- (b.) "My point is simply that there is an affordable housing project that is adjacent to a capped landfill and there is about to be another one and they are both financed by the Maine Housing Authority, so that is something to keep in mind."
