### **Old Business**

• <u>Social Media Use for School Employees</u> (GCSB)

In response to recent court rulings regarding First Amendment rights and social media, legal counsel recommends updating our policy to include clear guidelines on the use of social media by staff. The policy requires staff to provide language clarifying that opinions shared represent personal views, not those of the school department, when posting on social media. The committee discussed the use of social media platforms as a communication tool and the potential problems that subsequently arise. Additional language was added to ensure that social media would be used as a supplementary source of communication, to push out information being communicated, and secondary to those strategies that directly reach students, families and the community.

This sample policy, developed by Drummond -Woodsum, is intended to provide guidance and protection to the district and its employees as they attempt to communicate effectively with stakeholders (i.e. students, families, community). The Committee will continue to review the policy language and determine if an accompany procedure should be added to the Policy Manual, as well.
